Commissioner Watchman was appointed as a representative from Apache County, however, according to the Maricopa County Assessor's records, Commissioner Watchman owns a home in Maricopa County. While this is not determinative that the Commission is acting in contradiction of the law, it is concerning that the IRC appears to not be honoring the intent and is not honoring the language of Prop 106. This is important to voters like me because Prop 106 (enacted by the voters) established what is supposed to be a transparent, fair, and representative independent redistricting commission.</p> <p>I understand that Commissioner Watchman might "reside" in Apache County, but it is possible that he actually resides in Maricopa County. Arizonans deserve transparency in our democracy, and the map drawing process is no exception, which is why the Commission should address this residency question immediately.</p> <p>The diligent work of the Commission so far gives me hope that the Commission and the commission's attorneys Chairwoman will do the right thing by giving this issue the serious consideration it deserves. The purpose of the IRC was to remove the responsibility for redistricting from the legislature in the hope that an independent commission would create fair and competitive districts where elections would be contested on the merits of policy, the legislative record and the quality of the constituent service provided.</p> <p>LD Map 16.0 is surely a disappointment judged by these metrics. It creates a super majority of extremely safe seats. Twenty-five or twenty-six out of the thirty total districts are safe seats, 12 democratic safe seats and fourteen republican safe seats. It is beyond debate that this map creates a super majority of safe seats. What are the consequences of that decision from a governance standpoint?</p> <p>First, the elected senators and representatives holding the safe seats have no incentive to compromise since their only concern about re-election is to avoid a primary challenge from their own party. They have literally no incentive to govern effectively because the quality of their legislative record will not matter in terms of their re-election. The only thing that will matter is avoiding a primary challenge which, in turn, will force them to the extremes of their respective parties.</p> <p>Second, the quality of the candidates who seek to serve in the legislature will suffer because who in their right mind will take on the challenge of running against an incumbent candidate in a district that is stacked against them by more than 20 points? Incumbents will cruise to re-election without regard to the quality of their constituent service or their legislative accomplishments. This will result in legislators who are not responsive to their constituents and challengers who have no credentials or qualifications.</p> <p>Third, the four or five districts where there will be actual competition in the general election are insufficient to create a sensible center that can foster bipartisan cooperation.</p> <p>In settling for LD 16.0, the IRC has ignored numerous proposed maps submitted that would create many more competitive districts while still protecting legitimate communities of interest. The consequence will be to lock in a polarized state legislature for the next decade.</p> <p>Arizona has real policy challenges that can only be addressed by our state legislature. This map will make it difficult, if not impossible, for the legislature to effectively address those policy challenges. Chair Neuberg expressed her desire to create maps that would improve governance. This map fails to meet her own criteria.</p> <p>December 22 is a self-imposed deadline, not a deadline imposed by law.
